With the joint effort from experts all over the globe, this MOOC is going to bring the cutting edge knowledge in implant dentistry to dentists from every corner of the world.

What is a MOOC?



MOOC stands for Massive Open On-line Course. MOOCs is one of the latest and most promising developments in the field of e-learning, where world's best universities are teaming up to deliver quality assured open online courses at a massive scale.

MASSIVE – as it attracts thousands of students from all over the world!

OPEN – as it is fully accessible on-line, for free, to everyone!

INNOVATIVE – as it is one of the latest developments in university education, supported by some of the leading global institutions through two large on-line platforms, edX and Coursera.

Why a MOOC in Implant Dentistry?

dental implants as part of comprehensive care. Even long practicing dentists who want to offer implant services to their patients have little opportunity to reach flexible, quality-assured and unbiased education in this discipline.

A comprehensive, unbiased, open course could offer the necessary basic concepts of implant dentistry to the dental students and the general practitioners, while also benefit intermediate and advanced clinicians.

Who is this Course for?

The MOOC in implant dentistry will be engineered to serve multiple groups of learners. Dental students and recent graduates will be able to gain a thorough understanding of implant dentistry through attending the whole sequence of the learning experience. Moreover advanced learners and even specialists will benefit from accessing selectively specific parts of the course, depending on their needs. Consequently, this MOOC could serve as a sequential interactive learning experience helping novices to gradually develop understanding and competence, but also as a 21st century “live” resource which experienced users will be able to navigate at will!

Furthermore, the course will be available in both English and Chinese, which will help to reach a more global audience.
